**This is an exciting opportunity and the first of its kind within Scottish Volleyball.**

This post is initially offered for a 6-month fixed term contract. However, this appointment is within a bigger programme of preparation and delivery of qualified Scottish beach athletes for the 2022 Birmingham Commonwealth Games. Subsequent funding for a continuation of the High-Performance Head coach role (past the initial 6-month appointment) has been factored into future planning dependant on a review of the High-Performance coach and the positive results against outcomes set within the initial appointment.

The successful candidate will share our passion and vision for the development of High-Performance beach volleyball and the appointed coach will be required to demonstrate a proven record of successful work with elite beach athletes and programmes.

Knowledge required for the role includes finance management, project delivery, IT, and statistical analysis, together with excellent leadership, planning, and communication skills. (Spoken English is essential).

Required also is the ability to influence, network and develop elite coaching contacts successfully within beach volleyball at an international level.

The salary range is wide in its scope as Scottish Volleyball would consider any successful candidate to be either based in Scotland and or in their country of origin for the contracted period and the range reflects the possibility of inclusion of a potential relocation package.
